- 1. Approval of minutes from 12/11/2018
 - a. ACTION TAKEN: Minutes approved unanimously.
- 2. Follow up of Action Items to begin Make-Ready
 - a. Check in on the MLP Operating Structure
 - i. Reviewed note from Jay.
 - b. Review and approve WG&E Phase 3 contract
 - i. ACTION TAKEN: Recommend that the Selectboard move forward with Phase III of the WG&E Contract, Make Ready, by a letter from the Selectboard. Approved Unanimously.
 - c. Utility pole attachment contracts
 - i. Reviewed materials sent.
 - ii. Next actions: Hold until Bill Ennen and/ or Town MLP Board determines we can move ahead.
 - d. Permit process for railroad crossings
 - WG&E flagged that on the WG&E for RR crossing. Four in all for the design.
 - ii. No construction in the RR right of way
 - iii. No conduit needed on the new bridges
 - e. Performance Bond
 - f. Insurance binder
- 3. NEE Design
 - a. Trevor and Doug visited Plainfield hut no electronics. Heat and power, overhead cable trays, etc.

- b. 100 AMP electrical service, Charlemont will do 60 AMP electrical service, similar to MBI.
- c. Interior was 8'x 15'. Height of the cable rack is 7' and a little.
- d. WG&E will send an engineer up the look at the space. Borrowed racks to play with in terms of using the space. 2 equipment racks, 1 battery rack. Most important next action.
 - i. Scheduled site visits with Otis, Alford and Mt. Washington in the new year.
 - ii. Generator we expect is part of the Emergency Mgmt grant.
 - MBI doesn't have one so everything would go down.
 Can we work together to supply both? Heavy draw loads were not wired onto the generator.
 - 2. Next action: Trevor will follow up with Peg & Dennis
 - iii. WG&E specified 4 20 AMP 120 208 circuits, 2 120V single phase circuit.
 - iv. Cooling? Update thermometer to record the daily low temperature.
- 4. Wired West Refunds
 - a. Trevor will continue following about bulk refunds
 - b. Trevor and Cheryl will work together to process refunds
 - i. Emails to the people who sends it back
 - ii. Outline a process
