The new drop subsidy will provide up to \$500 for a new service installation at any location not previously activated. The subsidy requires service activation, a one year service commitment and will have a \$200 early termination fee if service is canceled before one year (same as existing policy). The subsidy is available to locations which previously received a cold drop subsidy.
