# Charlemont Conservation Committee August 11th, 2022 6:00 pm Via conference call and in person, Town Hall Meeting Minutes

#### Appointments:

#### 1. 6:15 PM Public Hearing for Trout Unlimited

- A request to amend a final Order of Conditions submitted by the Deerfield River Watershed Chapter of Trout Unlimited was heard. The Amendment to the Order is for the expansion of the Rice Brook in-stream habitat enhancements to include 55 Potter's Road.
- Kris van Naerssen explained his project to the Commissioners
- Kris showed the Abutter notification mailing receipts
- No abutters came to the hearing
- Kris answered questions from Andy Mueller, Barbara Beall and the Commissioners
- At 5:27 Bill Harker made a motion to close the public hearing, seconded by Erica Chenoweth; All in Favor

  - The Sign off procedure was described for the new member.
  - Erica signed off for 2 locations that they visited

- 1. Letter from Paul Hicks re: solving for unpermitted structure within 200' of river
  - Thorne had contacted Hicks about the shed. The letter from Paul Hicks stated that they plan to raise the shed 6" and will move the shed at the end of their season.
  - Bill Harker made a motion to accept the letter, seconded by Thorne Palmer. All in favor.

  - The logger is working with DEP and the Forestry Department has okayed the forest cutting work.
  - Thorne got in touch with the logger and confirmed that everything was good.
- 2. <u>ConComm training opportunity from Joy Duperault (State NFIP Coordinator/Director, Flood</u> <u>Hazard Management Program MA Dept. of Conservation & Recreation)</u>
  - Joy is offering a training and is available on September 8<sup>th</sup> for an hour or 1.5 hours on dry and wet flood mitigation.
  - It could be at the next meeting and could be held at the fairgrounds.
