- 6. Discussed Fencing dangerous town property in Zoar picnic area.
 - Win and Chuck to inform Selectmen of needs in this area via site visit. Would reduce liability and enhance monitoring of Zoar entry area.
 - Kathy to coordinate with larger FRCOG Committee regarding funding for put-ins.
- 7. Agreed Chuck Bellows will research law regarding carrying alcohol onto the river AND controlling access and entry points via parking restrictions etc.
- 8. Agreed that when plan is approved a comprehensive plan for education, signage, and publicity will be necessary. To be discussed further.
- 9. Member agreed to get sworn by Town clerk if we haven't already.
- 10. Next meeting Wed Nov 7 at 6 PM.
