New Business/Discusssion

Four members of the mountain bike community have organized and presented to the Parks and Recreation Commissioners a plan for a dirt track on the Fairgrounds. The pump track will consist of hollows and berms to teach critical skills for mountain biking. This would be equivalent to a playground for beginning mountain bikers and would be free for the community. E-bikes would be allowed if less than 20 mph. This park would represent a low-risk feature which would only require regular insurance. This would be a permanent structure on the grounds. The board recommended that signage be included in the design. Members of the presenting group would like to enlist the New England Mountain Bike Association for help with the project. The cost of the project would be conservatively \$50,000 or less, which would be covered by various donations. Maintenance for the track would be retained by the group and a maintenance plan would be provided to the Parks and Recreation Commission. The Commission unanimously supported the idea and will await further development information from the presenting group.
