He does not want electricity, wants to use a composting toilet. As of now, he is just going to be a camper. A composting toilet will need a permit from the Building Inspector.
- 5. Riverfest: It was pointed out that Hager's Farm did not have a permit to sell fried dough at the event. Rob Lingle moved to send a note to Hager's to apply for a Food Permit the next time they are vendors. Also, an invoice should be sent for the past event at Riverfest. Trice Hyer seconded. The motion passed.
- 6. Cold River Package Store: DEP will re-review the well situation, and suggest changes in the plans. Hopefully they will grandfather the existing wells.
- 7. Ruth Cannavo moved that the BOH meeting scheduled for August 14, 2013 be cancelled, due to an expected lack of a quorum. Rob Lingle seconded. The motion passed.
- 8. The Board received five (5) Septic System Pumping Reports.
- 9. The Board received a Title 5 Inspection Report, that did not appear to be witnessed by Glen Ayers. Trice Hyer will follow up with Glen.
- 10. The meeting was adjourned at 9:50 pm.
