Meeting called to order at 7:15 pm

- 1. Minutes from April 8, 2015 approved through signatures
- 2. Charlotte Dewey confirmed the sixty-day deadline for the house at 8 Riddell Rd.
- 3. Doug Telling, Rob Lingle, Glen Ayers, and Jim Hawkins inspected the Inn, the barn, and the house at 8 Riddell Rd. on April 15, 2015.
  - -Extensive water damage on the first and second floors of the east wing
  - -Some water damage on the first and second floors of the west wing.
  - -Serious structural issues in the bar
  - -Looked at pictures taken by Glen Ayers
- 4. No action to be considered until the health agent and building inspector reports are submitted.
- 5. On May 6 WMPHA will hold a workshop on private wells. Registration form passed around.
- 6. Reviewed letter from Coalition for Responsible Retailing regarding tobacco regulations.
- 7. Reviewed letter from MAHB attorney Cheryl Sbarra responding to the CRP letter.
- 8. Reviewed checklist for tobacco regulations. Agreed to all. Want clarification regarding banning smoking in outdoor areas of restaurants where food is served.
- 9. Reviewed two water tests and one violation for a failure to test.
- 10. Reviewed a DEP audit of Berkshire East plan for testing water.
- 11. Pan Am will be spraying along tracks.
- 12. Reviewed four pumping reports. No problems.
- 13. Board of Selectmen will put a warrant article to ask for special legislation to change the Board of Health from five members to three.
- 14. Telling will look to see if there are programs the Board of Health can set up to help the elderly in town.
- 15. FRCOG accepted the town's application for brownfield inspections of the two Sherman properties on 8A.

- 16. The town task force on abandoned properties needs a representative from the Board of Health. To be continued.
- 17. Cannavo moved that all Board of Health permits starting in 2016 be withheld from Indian Plaza until all taxes are paid. Telling seconded. Passed unanimously.
- 18. Glen Ayers met with the sewer commissioners regarding the Warfield House. He urged that a plan be put in place to address the four failed septic systems. He suggested storage tanks and a monitored slow release during off hours into the sewer system.

Telling moved and Cannavo seconded a motion to adjourn. Vote: unanimous in the affirmative
