
Project Location

- 2,000 Feet North of Route 2
- South of Hawk Hill Road
 Intersection
- Crosses Oxbow Brook
- East Oxbow Road turns into West Oxbow Road (only route around bridge)





How did we get here?







Existing Issues

- Structurally Deficient
 - Posted to Restrict Truck Weights
 - 1 of 4 Steel Beams Out-of-Service with Concrete Barriers
- Only One Lane of Traffic
- Limited Sight Distance
- Substandard Bridge Rails and Approach Guardrails



What do we want to accomplish?

Project Scope & Goals

- Full Structure Replacement
 - New Superstructure (Deck & Beams)
 - New Concrete Foundations
 - Design to Current Standards
- Two Lanes of Traffic
- Improve Sight Distance
 - Adjust Roadway Vertical Profile
 - Modify Horizontal Alignment



Project Scope & Goals

- New Standard Bridge Barriers & Approach Guardrails
- Improve Hydraulic Opening
- Maintain Traffic Throughout Construction





Right of Way Acquisition Procedures

Right of Way (ROW) discussion – 25% Design


- Responsible for acquiring all necessary rights in public land for design, construction, and implementation of a project.
- Affected property owners will be contacted by personnel from the Town Of Charlemont or consultants representing the Town Of Charlemont.
- Procedures must comply with state and federal regulations governing the acquisition process.
 - Property owners are protected under Massachusetts General Laws, primarily Chapter 79.
 - If project receives federal funds, property owners are further protected under Title III of the Real Property Act of 1970, as amended.
- Fee takings, permanent easements, and/or temporary construction easements may be required.
- Preliminary plans are available for review at the Charlemont Town Hall.




Project Cost, Programming, & Funding

- Current/Preliminary Estimated Total Construction Costs ~ \$3,700,000
- Statewide Transportation Improvement Program (STIP/TIP) Federal
 Fiscal Year 2023
- Federal Funding:
 - Federal Highway Administration 80%
 - MassDOT 20%










Bridge Alternatives

- Adjacent Prestressed Concrete Box Beams
- Spread Prestressed Concrete Box Beams with a Composite Concrete Deck
- NEXT Beams
- Steel Stringers with a Composite Concrete Deck






Steel Stringers with a Composite Concrete Deck



What are the environmental and cultural resource impacts?

Environmental & Cultural Resource

Environmental

- Obtain Necessary Environmental Permits
- Use of Erosion and Sediment Control Barriers
- Tree Removal to Facilitate Construction

Cultural Resource

- No Work Proposed on Agricultural Preservation Restrictions (APR) Land East of Bridge
- Land West of Bridge with Chapter 61 Restrictions Require Temporary Easements





Full Bridge Closure with Temporary Bridge

- No Traffic on Existing Bridge During Construction
 - Entire Bridge Demolished at Once
 - Traffic Pattern Temporarily Shifts

Temporary Bridge

- Constructed West of Existing Bridge
- One Traffic Lane Wide
- One Lane of Alternating Traffic for Majority of Construction
- Traffic Signals Required to Allow Vehicles to Travel from Both Approaches


Short-Term Closures

- Narrow Space for Construction
- Detour Necessary for Various Construction Activities (Beam Installation, Paving, etc.)

Road User Impacts

- Limited Traffic Delays
 - Low Traffic Volume
 - Signal for Alternating Traffic Direction over Temporary Bridge
- Limited Detours
 - Anticipated for Some Short Construction Activities
 Due to Limited Space
 - Only Route is West Oxbow Road
 - Detour is Approx. 4.7 Miles (~ 10-15 Min.)
- Safety
 - Barriers Separating Construction Work Zone
 - Traffic Controls & Signing Directing Vehicles
- Hawk Hill Road
 - Access Maintained Throughout Construction




