COVID vaccine – are you up to date? In late February 2024, CDC added a new recommendation that people aged 65 years and older should receive 1 additional dose of any updated (2023–2024 Formula) COVID-19 vaccine (i.e., Moderna, Novavax, Pfizer-BioNTech).

This additional dose, given at least 4 months after first dose of 23-24 formula vaccine, is to boost protection during the summer months.

Cooperative Public Health Nurses are providing Moderna COVID vaccine in home visits, and at drop-in nursing hours, through the spring and early summer by appointment only. If you would like to receive this additional dose, or if you still need a first dose of the 2023-24 formula that came out in Sept 2023,
